
AN EXHORTATION ON RIGHTEOUSNESS



34th Annual National Ijtima of Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya & Majlis Atfalul Ahmadiyya Canada

All days of the Ijtima started with Tahajjud at Masjid Baitul Islam at 4:30 AM followed by Fajr at 5:45 AM. Alhamdolillah the main floor of Masjid Baitul Islam was full at the time of Tahajjud with the Khuddam and Atfal attendees of Ijtima.

- Total Khuddam Ijtima Attendance: 3,313
- Total Atfal Ijtima Attendance: 1,445
- Total number of volunteers: 570

A special arrangement of Duroos was made each day on the topics: Gender Identity, Drugs and Addiction, Halal Earning, and Pornography. On the third and the last day of Ijtima, all Sports and Educational competitions concluded before Zuhr and Asr prayers. The closing session started at around 2:20 PM with Tilawat, followed by Pledge, Nazm, Ijtima Reports, and prize distribution.

After the prize distribution, Respected Azhar Haneef Sahib delivered a very faith-inspiring address on how to protect ourselves from the harmful effects of society and how Khilafat Ahmadiyya acts as a shield. The closing session concluded with a silent prayer followed by a group photo.

This year a total of 17 educational competitions were held in which 461 Khuddam participated. For sports, 8 individual and 6 team competitions were held in which more than 1,000 Khuddam participated. Continuing from previous years, some exciting activities were added to Khuddam Hub, including wall climbing, Saabit Qadmi (one-legged wrestling), e-games, and many more, were available for Khuddam to participate in.





Along with the Hub and Workshop marquees, we had set up 16 food stalls. Besides that, we had a Special Needs marquee that had S.E.N.D services and was set up to cater to Khuddam and Atfal with special needs. This year, 10 different workshops were held on a wide range of topics and issues being faced by Khuddam on a day-to-day basis. These workshops were attended by over 750 Khuddam. Bonfire informal question and answer sessions were held on Friday and Saturday night which were well attended by over 1,000 Khuddam. In addition, there was a Khilafat exhibition alongside the "Light of Quran Exhibition" which were visited by over 300 Khuddam.

There were two booths established by MASQ and Alislam. A very interesting 'Existence Project Experience' including a blind tasting experience, was held by the Review of Religions and was attended by over 750 Khuddam.

A bookstore was also set up where many of the publications of Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Canada were placed for sale, with over 1,000 Khuddam visiting the store.

MKAC Studios provided a three-day livestream full of original content and studio sessions with a total viewership across four videos of more than 14,000 views. We interviewed over 40 members during the Ijtima.

A total of 27 individual videos, 3 promo videos, and over 7 YouTube shorts in promotion of the Ijtima were published. Over 30,000 views in the past 28 days leading up to and during the Ijtima. Over the period of Ijtima, food was prepared from Langar Khana for volunteers and the attendees before, after, and during Ijtima with a total serving of more than 90,000.

Over 4,500 man-hours were dedicated over many weeks by Khuddam from across the GTA to make this Ijtima the success that it is.

INSPECTION REPORT





AUGUST 24, 2023

The inspection of the Ijtima was held in the Baitul Islam Complex. The inspection started from the main Ijtima marquee where more than 300 volunteers along with their respective Nazimin and Naib Nazimin Ala were present.

Respected Azhar Haneef Sahib spoke about the importance of serving the faith at the utmost level. He narrated his Hajj incident from 25 years ago, in 1998, where he was impressed by the level of service.

In 1998, where he was impressed by the level of service provided by the Jama'at members over there and he highlighted that they were preparing for the day to welcome Khilafat Ahmadiyya to the Kaaba and Mecca. He advised to the volunteers that we should also aim for the highest level of service.

After the opening remarks, a silent prayer was held followed by announcements and then Maghrib and Isha prayers were held. After the prayers, respected Azhar Haneef Sahib visited the Office and Admin marquee where he met and was introduced to all the Office Nazimin and volunteers.

During the inspection of the Office marquee, a very heavy thunderstorm started. Despite heavy rains, respected Azhar Haneef Sahib continued to visit the MKAC Studios and Audio/Video marquee. From there he continued inside the main marquee where most of the other Naib Nazimin Ala along with their respective Nazimin and volunteers were present. From the main marquee, he continued outside under the heavy rain to the Registration marquee where he met Nazimin and volunteers of, Parking & Security. From there he was taken to the Khilafat Exhibition, Book Store, and Review of Religions marquee.



From there we continued to the Food marquee where Nazimin and volunteers of the Hospitality and Ijtima Setup teams were present.

After that, he visited the Langar Khana where Diyafat Nazimin and volunteers were present. In the end, respected Azhar Haneef Sahib was taken to the Atfal litima Gah in Aiwan Tahir. Alhamdolillah many Nazimin and volunteers had a chance to speak and meet with respected Azhar Haneef Sahib. The inspection concluded at 10:23 PM.







































AUG 25TH, 2023

DAY 1



The Day started with Khuddam offering Tahajjud at Baitul Islam Mosque at 4:30 AM followed by Fajr at 5:45 AM. More than 500 Khuddam were served breakfast which started at 7:00 AM. The Ijtima Registration started at 10:00 AM followed by running lunch that started at 12:30 PM. More than 1700 Khuddam were served lunch.

After offering Jumah and Asr prayers, by the Grace of Allah, MKAC held a successful press conference. this purpose of The press conference was to announce the launch of the "Light of Quran" campaign which was a response to the unfortunate Quran burnings that taking place Sweden. in other Denmark and several countries.

The panel consisted of respected Azhar Haneef Sahib, respected National Amir Sahib Canada and Sadr Majlis. Moderated by Hassaan Shahid, Chairman Press/Media MKAC. Each member of the panel delivered a brief statement. A quote of beloved Huzoor Anwar (aa) was also read from the Press Release issued by Markaz.



Four news outlets attended: CTV Toronto, The Globe and Mail, OMNI News and the Vaughan Citizen. After the press conference, the Flag Hoisting took place at 2:30 PM. The Opening session started at around 2:35 PM.

After Tilawat, the Khuddam Pledge and Nazm, respected National Amir Sahib Canada read out the message that we received from our beloved Imam, Syedna Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper!).

While the message was being read out, a printed enlarged message was also unveiled that was set up outside in the Ijtima Gah. After the message was read out, respected Azhar Haneef Sahib gave his opening remarks in which he reiterated the message from Huzoor Anwar (aa) about creating a stong and living connection with Allah Tala.

The whole opening session was streamed LIVE with an online total viewership of 2100. MKAC Studios broadcasted a whole day Ijtima streaming with 8 hours of LIVE content that consisted of multiple interviews. A total of 28 video interviews of attendees were recorded by the Studios.


Soon after the opening session the Educational and Sports competitions commenced. A total of 53 Khuddam participated in Tilawat and Nazm competitions. Sports competitions continued in which more than 950 Khuddam participated in the following sports: Arm wrestling, Strongest Khadim, Javelin, 100m race, Basketball, Hockey, Soccer, Cricket, Volleyball and Tug of war.

Along with the Educational and Sports competitions, different activities were organized to keep Khuddam engaged. A Hub Marquee had different recreational activities. Different Workshops were organized that consisted of different topics. Along with the Hub and Workshop marquees, we had set up 16 food stalls. Beside that we had a Special Needs marquee that had S.E.N.D services. Besides the Special Needs marquee, a marquee was the set up that consisted of Exhibition, Book store and Review of Religions. A special sitting of respected Azhar Haneef sahib was held with the PAAMA Khuddam. Later a sitting with Arab Khuddam took place. At the end respected Sadr Majlis held a meeting with all Qaidin Majalis. After the sports and educational competition, dinner was served to more than 2100 Khuddam.



Sports Competitions resumed on the second day at 8:30 AM. More than 931 Khuddam participated in different sports, individual and team sports competitions.


Today was the first day of Majlis Ahmadiyya's **Annual** Atfalul litima which started with the flag hoisting at 10:00AM, followed by the opening session in the main marquee. The Educational competitions continued on the second day. After Zuhr and Asr prayers, the second session of Khuddam litima commenced. Respected Sadr Sahib Mailis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Canada addressed the Khuddam on the topic of "Upholding our Pledge".



Respected Sadr Sahib Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Canada shared incidents of those who underscored the significance of sacrificing one's life, wealth, time, and honour. Through these narratives, he emphasized not only the value of these sacrifices but also highlighted how one can best prepare to embrace them and the abundant rewards that await those who do.

After the address from respected Sadr Majlis, a Question and Answer session was held in which Khuddam asked a range of questions. After the second session, the competitions continued. At the same time multiple Workshops, were held on topics such as; Gender Identity, Technology and Faith, Al Today and Tomorrow, Financial Literacy, and Parenting styles. More than 225 Khuddam took benefit from these Workshop sessions. MKAC Studios continued doing the LIVE streaming of the ljtima for the second day with a viewership of more than 2500. More than 10 hours of LIVE content was streamed and 35 interviews of Nazimin, guests and volunteers were taken.

Alhamdulillah, by the Grace of Allah, it was a very successful day in terms of exposure of the National Ijtima to politicians across Ontario

More than a dozen politicians visited our litima Gah. Dignitaries included the Provincial minister of Education, Deputy/Acting Mayor of Vaughan, Deputy Mayor of Innisfil, MPP Regional Council for the city of Vaughan, MPP of North York, MP Etobicoke Center and MP Ottawa Center. A special dinner was held at 7 PM in which all Jama'at and Mailis Ansarullah Canada's National Amila was invited. After the dinner Maghrib and Isha prayers were offered.

This year Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Canada had a separate marquee of Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND) for Khuddam and Atfal who have special needs. This was established following the recommendation of Majlis Shura. We were able to accommodate and serve 7 Atfal with special needs.

By the grace of Allah, the first two days of the Review of Religion exhibition proved to be very successful. In total 5 shows have took place in the auditorium with a total of well over 250 Khuddam who attended. The blind taste test received resoundingly positive feedback. Khuddam were surprised to see such a unique setup and appreciated the way in which the experiment was conducted and the explanation which was later given. Khuddam have also positively responded to the talks, especially the ones refuting arguments of atheism.

At the end of the day, a second Bonfire session was held at 9:00 PM in which Khuddam asked different marriage-related questions. The session lasted for more than an hour. Sweet corn and Kashmiri tea were served to more than 300 attendees. The session ended with a silent prayer.

23rd National Majlis Shura

By the Grace of Allah, Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Canada held its 23rd National Majlis Shura on October 13 and 14, 2023 in Peace Village, Vaughan, Canada. This year, our beloved Imam, Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) approved 4 proposals to be included in the agenda of this Majlis Shura. A total of 356 Shura delegates joined Majlis Shura from across Canada.

Respected Sadr Majlis led the Khuddam in taking the pledge. This time the new pledge that Huzoor Anwar (aa) took from Khuddam at the occasion of MKA UK National ljtima was taken from Khuddam at Shura as well.

For those who came from distant accommodation regions, transportation was arranged. On the first day of Majlis Shura, national departments of Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Canada presented their year-round reports. Similarly, the implementation reports on past Mailis Shura approved recommendations also were presented.

After this, there was a question and answer session where Majlis Shura delegates were able to ask questions from the National Representatives regarding their responsibilities throughout the year. 












WAQF NAU IJTIMA


- Qur'an Literacy and allegations against The Holy Quran
